

# Summer Enrichment Program Offerings

## **Kick Off to Kindergarten**

(Entering Kindergarten students only)

Students will be provided with skill review and hands-on learning centers to support Kindergarten readiness. All activities will provide extra support with language skills, phonemic awareness and math concepts to prepare them for their kindergarten year.

## **War of 1812 Forts**

(Grades 2- 5) *\*field trips\**

Students will tour Fort Ontario in Oswego and Sackett's Harbor Battlefield\walking trail. They will learn about how the forts helped the US during the War of 1812, discover what worked with the forts and what weaknesses they had. They will study the geography and how that aided the US. Afterwards, the kids will design and build their own forts.

## **Yoga & Mindfulness**

(Grades 1 - 5)

Students will explore yoga sequences, yoga and mindfulness stations, and end the class with yoga and mindfulness crafts.

## **STEM Building**

(Kindergarten - Grade 5)

Students will engage in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) related activities to encourage critical thinking and problem solving strategies. Upon arriving for the afternoon students will be given a task card challenge along with a box of materials to utilize to help them meet the task card challenge. Students will need to be able to write, work with math concepts, and problem solve in order to complete tasks. Students will be working on public speaking skills to present and explain their process.

## **Ready to ROBO**

(Grades 3 - 4)

\*\*\* This is a 2 week program offering, students attend both weeks during the same time each week.\*\*\*

In week one the students will learn the building blocks of how to build robots as well as how to code and program robots.

In week two the students will complete a STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math) Robotics Challenge using their robot from the previous week.

## **Stream Monitoring**

(Grades 4 - 5) *\*field trip to streams*

Students will be exploring the wonders of fishing stream and & river habitats in this week-long program. Students will Learn to measure current speed, build a stream sampling net, and sample aquatic organisms using a stream sampling net.

## **Pulaski's Past**

(Grades 3 - 5)

Learn about and explore the local history in and around the Pulaski area. Students will embark on walking field trips to local historical sites to learn about the area and the significance of Pulaski's history. They will explore the many people and places that make Pulaski unique.

## **PE Party**

(Grades 3 - 5)

Students will engage in a variety of activities that benefit them physically, socially, and emotionally. Students are encouraged to develop a life –long passion for sports and physical activities. Such activities may include, but are not limited to, archery, badminton, basketball, and innovative technology.
