**Meeting minutes:** May meeting minutes approved.

**Treasurer Report:** Our combined balance is \$14,755. We purchased a rubbermaid shed for the modified baseball and softball fields for \$701.99 and paid \$150 toward a basketball clinic for the summer by Oswego State's head coach. We are holding \$304 for the wrestling team from their fundraiser.

**Fundraising Report:** Mother's Day raffle was a profit of \$706.64 and the lotto raffle was \$390. The Father's Day raffle is still up, not many have purchased spots yet. 50 spots at \$10 a spot. We will keep sharing and possibly add prizes to it to get them filled.

## **Old Business:**

- a. Fundraising:
  - 1. Student Involvement Jordan thinks that this year the varsity club will be more motivated if an end of the year trip is reinstated. We will add phone numbers to the sign up for the snack shack so we can remind students that they volunteered. We will also leave adult names off the sign ups until students have had a chance. They will also be required to have volunteer hours to be eligible for the Booster's Senior Award and Summer Camp Grant. Need to extend opportunities to seniors that need their community service hours.
  - 2. Parent Involvement Hoping for more parent involvement this year now that we are established and people know what we do.

- 5. Cans/bottles Shed If approved we would like to place it at the bus garage near our snack shack. Riverview will pick up when full and we receive 6 cents being a non-profit. Tom thinks it is a great idea and will ask for approval from the board in July.
- 6. Community Reach Announcement on the PACS website, newsletter, link on website

- c. Countertop for Lower Concession Stand Mr. Basciani suggested we ask the shop teacher or seniors first. Possibly wrap it with metal to last longer.
