Dear Parents/Guardians:

Yesterday, Governor Hochul announced that effective Wednesday, March 2nd, New York State will no longer require masks in schools but that counties and cities could continue to require masks based on local circumstances. Today, the Oswego County Health Department has confirmed that they will not be imposing a mask mandate on schools.

Beginning Wednesday, masks will not be required for PACS students and staff in school facilities or transportation. It is important to note that any student who prefers to continue wearing a mask in school may do so. Masks will be provided for anyone who requests them.

The District will also continue to provide free at-home COVID tests as long as supplies last. Please contact your child's school to request tests.
