

PTG Virtual Meeting Minutes: November 12, 2020

Meeting was called to order at 6:05 pm

October minutes were motioned to be approved by Cathy and seconded by Christy.

Teacher Report: Rachael had nothing new to report. Charlee sent an email that there would be a materials pick up for virtual students on November 24th if we have anything that needs to be sent home.

Principal Report: The staff and students are doing most everything virtual to keep everyone safe and healthy, such as the Veteran's Day Celebration and Morning Program. Merry Go Round Theater, which is called Rev Theater, those are going to be virtual for the remainder of the school year. All students will be able to participate whether they are virtual or in person. Make-up pictures are scheduled for December 18th.

Treasurer Report: Mini sessions deposit of \$150, this does not include any venmo payments or money taken in for the last few days. They will be included in next month's report. We will transfer Julie's portion via venmo at the end of the fundraiser. There was a recent deposit of \$656 from Square 1 Art that will be removed from this budget and added to last year's budget. We are at a balance of \$13,517.79.

Old Business: Cherrydale - we had a really successful sale and made \$2922. Products should be in 2-3 weeks and Christy has a list of orders being sent to school so we can easily distribute, possibly deliver a few that we need to. There was a donation of \$220 left in the office from a 5th grade student and his family in lieu of ordering from Cherrydale. Virtual craft night - nothing at this point. Rachel R. has been added to the group chat with Jenn and Kate to try to plan a take home craft night for December. Holiday Mini Sessions - we filled the first day, November 14th and the second day on the 21st is half full. Sessions are \$50, we get half and Julie gets half. Wes will send out an email to all participants with pertinent information needed for the day of the mini sessions. Wes and Gina will be assisting Julie the day of the sessions. Wes is going to put posts on some community sites to try to fill up the last few slots on the 21st. Toy Sale - will be at Park United Methodist Church, collection days are November 19th and 20th, and sale dates are November 21st and 23rd. Jess will send out an email to our PTG Pals group asking for volunteers. At this point, Jess, Kate, and Christy have

volunteered. Christy has wipes and hand sanitizer, and will help with problem solving with guidelines, etc. if things change in our community prior to the sale. Pulaski Pride Shirts - Shannon has been helping Joelle, she contacted both B&T and Fulton Screen Printing. B&T prices were higher for youth sizes so they are going to use Fulton Screen Printing. Overall costs for students is \$2096.60, we have about 37 students that need adult size shirts, but youth shirts are still cheaper. Youth shirts at \$5.30 and adult shirts are \$6.10. We are ordering 390 shirts. Order is all set, it has to be sent in. Jana will pay the district when she receives an invoice. We may need to place another order later in the year for additional shirts depending on what the spring looks like. We have \$2500 in the budget if we need to reorder.

New Business: Holiday Light Contest - Cathy created a flyer and contest to help boost some holiday cheer in our community with 3 different prizes. Cathy will donate the gift card. We have a Savearound book and items in our closet for a holiday gift basket. Participants will send photos or videos for us to put on our page and people will vote. Winners will be determined by most likes. Virtual Sip and Paint - Jess will send an email to Mrs. Jennings and try to plan it for January or February. Raffle Calendar - we are basically set with donations, we may need a couple more. Gina will help with arranging the calendar. Wes will ask for color copies to be donated. Sneaker Drive - Cathy created a flyer and it was sent home, and posted on facebook. We receive up to \$3 per shoe, depending on the use of the shoe. Wes will also post on community sites.

Additional information: Gina's friend sent her information on steps to set us up as non-profit. We will tackle this in the winter and talk more about it at our January meeting. Christy asked Joelle what the school needs are at this point, and how we can help. She will let us know.
