This morning, Governor Andrew Cuomo announced that all New York school districts are authorized to reopen for the 2020-2021 academic year.

Previously, you received information from Tom Jennings, Superintendent of Pulaski Academy and Central Schools, regarding the reopening plan for our district. District teams and committees made up of administrators, directors, teachers, and staff have worked collaboratively to create a plan that complies with guidance from the New York State Education Department and New State Health Department. It has been and will continue to be our commitment to offer every student a safe, high-quality learning experience. Lura Sharp Elementary will be opening its doors to students Pre-Kindergarten through 5<sup>th</sup> grade full time on September 8, 2020. Parents have the option of sending their child(ren) to school or to participate in the remote virtual learning option. If any parent would like to have their child participate in the remote virtual learning option they must complete the [Remote Learning Commitment Survey](#) by Monday, August 10<sup>th</sup>. You can click on the link or visit the district website to access the form. This form is needed to help us plan for the elementary class lists. If you do not complete the Remote Learning Commitment Survey we will move forward and place your child(ren) in a classroom for September. Parents and Guardians can look for additional information regarding student placements the week of August 17.
