Dear Parent/Guardian,

Hello everyone, I hope your summer is going well. We are quickly approaching the first day of school, so I would like to pass along some transportation information. As you may know, riding the bus this school year is going to be different. With that said, I would like to share the transportation bus expectations and a glance at riding the bus this school year.

I would like to remind all parents/guardians that if your child is showing any symptoms of the coronavirus, please keep your child at home and do not send them on the bus. Symptoms include: fever, cough, shortness of breath, fatigue, body ache, headache, loss of taste, sore throat, congestion, runny nose, nausea, vomiting and/or diarrhea.

Before your child boards the school bus, their *temperature will be taken by devices* installed on each bus. The district recommends that an adult be home with your child during the morning routes. In the event that your child has a temperature of 100 degrees or higher, the child will not be allowed to ride the bus and attend school. Please expect variations in pick up times each morning due to having to take student's temperatures.

While your student is on the bus, we do have **bus expectations** to ensure that the bus routes run safely as possible. Please discuss these with your student before the first day of school:

- Students are to wear their masks at all times
- Students are to keep their hands to themselves
- Students are to remain in their seats at all times
- Siblings, members of the same household and members of the same daycare will be required to sit together
- No eating or drinking on the bus due to the fact that it requires removal of your mask

Bus Passes: Due to pandemic response, changes in student transportation that require bus passes must be limited. The school offices will only issue bus passes for emergency child care situations.
