Dear Parents/Guardians:

The school district was notified today that one of our Pulaski Middle-High School staff members has tested positive for COVID-19. The staff member was last in school on Tuesday, October 27th. We are unable to provide specific information regarding any staff member or student who tests positive due to privacy regulations.

The district is working closely with the Health Department as they conduct contact tracing with individuals who were in close contact with the staff member. Any students or staff who have been within close proximity are being contacted directly by the Department of Health and may be placed in mandatory quarantine.

In order to allow time for the Health Department to conduct their work and make recommendations, all school activities scheduled for Friday, Saturday, and Sunday are cancelled. We will be working closely with the Health Department through the weekend to determine next steps and will communicate that information as soon as possible.
