Dear Parents/Guardians:

As you are aware, the school district was notified yesterday that one of our Pulaski Middle-High School staff members tested positive for COVID-19. We worked closely with the Oswego County Health Department as they conducted contact tracing and identified individuals for mandatory quarantine. Due to the number of staff members required to quarantine by the health department, the Pulaski Middle-High School, Academic Center, and Make Sense Shop will be shifting to a fully remote model for the quarantine period. Athletics and all other after-school activities will be canceled during this time. In-person instruction for Middle-High School students will resume on Thursday, November 12th.

No students or staff at Lura Sharp Elementary School have been directly impacted by these quarantine orders, therefore, the elementary school will continue to operate on a normal schedule and elementary students will continue with in-person instruction on Monday.

While this is not an outcome we hoped for, it is one we have been preparing for. On Monday, Middle-High School students should log into google classroom to review assignments for the day but they will not need to follow their regular remote online schedule. If your child needs to retrieve their chromebook from school, please contact the main office on Monday at 315.298.5103 to arrange it. Starting Tuesday, teachers will be providing live instruction and students are expected to log into google classroom for their regular online class schedule. Students will also need to log into non-core classes on their color day. For example, Crimson group students will log into all their classes on crimson days but only core classes (social studies, math, science, English, Spanish, resource room) on Blue days.

Middle-High School students who attend CITI CTE programs, P-TECH, New Visions, or full day special programs will still attend these programs during this period. Students will be picked up by bus directly from their homes between 7:15 and 7:45. Please contact the Transportation Department with questions at 315.298.7378.

During this period, we will be delivering meals to all middle-high students whose families request it. Deliveries will be made to Crimson students on November 2nd and 9th. Deliveries to Blue students will be on November 4th. We will be delivering meals to students who originally opted for the 100% virtual program on November 2nd and 9th in place of the Tuesday meal pick-up day.
