Dear Parents/Guardians:

We were notified tonight that one of our Middle-High School staff has tested positive for COVID-19. The district is working closely with the Oswego County Health Department as they conduct contact tracing with individuals who were in close contact. In order to allow time for the Health Department to conduct their work, the Middle-High School will shift to remote learning tomorrow, Thursday, November 19th. Those who have been in close contact will be contacted directly by the Health Department as well as the District.

The COVID positive individual has had no contact with the elementary school or elementary students. Lura Sharp Elementary School will be open tomorrow for in-person instruction.

We will be working closely with the Health Department tomorrow to determine next steps and will communicate that information as soon as possible.
