In response to increasing COVID cases in the community during the holidays and the impact on school staffing, all Pulaski students grades Pre-K through 12 will switch to remote online learning from home January 4th through January 8th. Pulaski students who attend CITI CTE programs, P-TECH, New Visions, or full day special programs will also switch to remote learning during this time. The District will switch back to in-person instruction on Monday, January 11th.

Elementary
