| <b>July 7 - 14, 2023</b>   | Scholarship letter and packets with the criteria and application materials mailed home to eligible seniors.   |
| <b>September 7, 2023</b>   | Scholarship overview and reminder provided to seniors on Day 1 of school year. Verification that all eligible seniors have received the application packets occurs.<br><br><i>NOTE: Extra packets available in the <b>HS Guidance Office</b>.</i>         |
| <b>September 7, 2023 -<br/>December 22, 2023</b>   | Seniors notified to schedule appointments with District Principal, Mr. Bateson, and begin working on projects. Seniors should seek to <b>complete and turn in Part I &amp; Part II of application packet to Guidance Secretary, Ms. Gronosky a.s.a.p.</b> |
| <b>December 31, 2023 this is a Sunday – do we want to move it to the Friday before or the Monday after?</b><br><b>Deadline to apply</b> for the <i>Snow Academic Achievement Scholarship</i> . [Meeting with administrator to review and discuss Application Parts I & II must have occurred.] |   |
| <b>January 2-5, 2024</b>   | Reminder emails sent via school email to seniors completing community service projects for a project update.  |
| <b>January 2, 2024 –<br/>April 1, 2024</b>   | <b>Seniors should secure letters of support; complete all checklist items for application, and be completing Parts III &amp; IV of application.</b>   |
| <b>April 19, 2024</b>  | <b>Completed Scholarship Applications due back to HS Guidance Secretary, Ms. Gronosky.</b>  |
| <b>April 29 – May 3 2024</b>   | Interview notification emails sent to student’s school email with regard to time and place of interview.  |
| <b>May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2024</b>   | Tentative interview date for scholarship candidates.  |
